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3. PRECAUTIONS

- During winter time, check if wiper blades are frozen to the windshield.
- Wiper operation with the blades frozen can damage the wiper blade and motor.
- The wiper operation on the dry windshield can scratch the glass and wear the blade prematurely. Do not operate the wiper when the windshield is dry.
- When it does not rain, turn the wiper switch into the "OFF" position.
- Turn the wiper switch to the "OFF" position before any car wash to avoid unwanted operation of the wipers.
- Check if the rain sensor is in position securely when removing, fitting and checking it.
- Be sure to use the wiper blade with specified size.
- Be careful so a maldetection does not occur due to the sticker and foreign materials in the rain sensor sensing part at the windshield glass.



A CAUTION

When cleaning the windshield over the sensor with damp clothes, the wiper may operate suddenly. It could cause serious injury. Make sure to place the wiper switch to the OFF position and ignition switch OFF when not in use.

Irregular operation (abrupt operation)


- Check if the sensor is not displaced.
- Check if the rain sensor cover is securely installed.
- Check if the customer is familiar with how to control the wiper sensitivity. Check if the wiper sensitivity control is set to the FAST side (step 5).
- Check the wiper blades for wear.
- If the wiper blade cannot wipe the glass uniformly and clearly, it may cause the rain sensor to work irregularly. Therefore, in this case, replace the wiper blade with a new one.

OVERVIEW AND OPERATING PROCESS

1. OVERVIEW

1) Windshield Wiper System

The wiper and rain sensor system consists of the wiper switch, windshield wiper motor and linkage, wiper arm and blade, rain sensor, wiper relay (LO/HI) and washer tank. The rain sensor does not directly operate the rain sensing wiper and it sends only the data of the rainfall to the BCM. The basic operation of the wiper and washer is controlled by the BCM according to the signals from the multifunction switch operation (MIST, AUTO, LO/HI, washer, sensitivity adjustment).




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2) Rear Wiper System

The rear wiper system consists of the wiper switch, rear wiper motor, wiper arm and blade, rear wiper relay. The basic operation of the wiper and washer is controlled by the BCM according to the signals from the multifunction switch operation (LO/HI, washer).



3) Rain Sensor System

In the rain sensing wiper operation system, the rain sensing unit only sends the information about the amount of rain drops to the BCM, and it does not operate the wiper directly. The wiper and washer are controlled by the BCM according to the driver's choice.

AUTO light and rain sensor module



This sensor emits infrared rays through LED and then detects the amount of rain drops by receiving the rays reflected off the sensing section (rain sensor mounting section on the windshield) with photodiode.

AUTO operation and sensitivity control



AUTO:

Wiper operates automatically by rain sensor **FAST <-----> SLOW:**

Auto delay/auto speed control. timberlake96: A position that can control the sensitivity for the amount of rains on the windshield and transmit the wiping request signal accordingly.

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The rain sensor detects the amount of rain drops and sends the operating request signal to the BCM, which drives the wiper directly. At this moment, the BCM also sends the information on whether the wiper is in operation mode or whether the multifunction wiper switch is in AUTO position to the rain sensor.


























3. OPERATING PROCESS

1) Multifunction Wiper Switch Operation Mode



1. MIST

- When the wiper switch is pushed up to the mist position, the windshield wipers cycle once and then stop in the parking position.

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- Stops the windshield wiper operation.

3. AUTO

- When the wiper switch is set to the AUTO position, the wiper speed is adjusted automatically according to the amount of rain detected by the rain sensor mounted on the windshield.

4. LO/HI

- When the wiper switch is set to the LO position, the wiper speed is decreased. When the switch is set to the HI position, the wiper speed is increased.

5. Front wiper volume sensitivity switch

- When the wiper switch is in AUTO position, the wiper speed can be adjusted as follows:
 - * FAST: increases wiper speed
 - * SLOW: decreases wiper speed

6. AUTO washer switch

 When the AUTO washer switch is pressed, the washer fluid is sprayed once and the wiper cycles 4 times. Then, the fluid is sprayed once again with 3 cycles of the wiper.

7. Rear wiper switch

Operates the rear wiper.

8. Pull

- The windshield washer fluid is sprayed out and front wiper operates only when the switch is being pulled.

9. Push

- The rear washer fluid is sprayed out and rear wiper operates only when the switch is being pressed down.





Operation 2. (windshield washer switch pulled for 0.6 seconds or more)

- D. Windshield washer switch is ON for more than 0.6 sec. (T5)
- E. After 0.3 sec. (T1), windshield wiper LO relay is activated.
- F. Windshield washer switch is OFF.
- G. Windshield wiper LO relay is deactivated after windshield wiper motor rotates 3 turns (T3).





(2) Windshield washer switch coupled wiper operation during intermittent wiper operation

Basic condition

 Windshield intermittent wiper operates with IGN ON and wiper AUTO switch in ON position.

Operation 1. (windshield washer switch pulled for 0.1 to 0.59 sec.)

- A. Windshield washer switch is ON for 0.1 to 0.59 sec. (T2)
- B. After 0.5 sec. (T1), windshield wiper LO relay is activated.
- C. Windshield wiper LO relay is deactivated after windshield wiper motor rotates 1 turn (T5).
- D. Intermittent wiper operation is started by windshield wiper LO relay after rest time (T6).

Operation 2. (windshield washer switch pulled for 0.6 seconds or more)

- E. Windshield washer switch is ON for 0.6 (T3) seconds or more.
- F. After 0.5 sec. (T1), windshield wiper LO relay is activated.
- G. Windshield washer switch is OFF.
- H. Windshield wiper LO relay is deactivated after windshield wiper motor rotates 3 turns (T4).
- I. Intermittent wiper operation is started by windshield wiper LO relay after rest time (T6).

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
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
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(3) Windshield auto washer switch coupled windshield wiper operation Operation 1.

- A. With IGN ON and windshield wiper auto switch is OFF.
- B. Windshield auto washer switch is ON for 0.1 seconds or more (T1) and windshield washer motor is ON for 2.0 seconds (T2).
- C. The windshield wiper LO relay is operated 4 times (T5) 0.5 seconds (T4) after the windshield washer motor has been activated.
- D. Windshield washer motor is activated for 1.5 seconds (T3) and the windshield wiper LO relay is deactivated after 3 times (T6) of operation.




- Input from windshield auto washer is overridden during windshield washer motor operation.
- The second input from windshield auto washer is overridden during windshield auto washer linked windshield wiper operation.
- Input from windshield auto washer is overridden during speed sensitive intermittent wiper operation.
- When ON signal of windshield intermittent wiper switch is received during windshield auto washer operation, windshield auto washer stops operation and windshield intermittent wiper operation starts.
- Input from windshield washer switch is overridden during windshield auto washer operation.


- A. Rear wiper switch is ON.
- B. After 0.1 sec. (T1), rear wiper relay is activated.
- C. Rear wiper switch is OFF.
- D. Rear wiper relay is deactivated upon receiving rear wiper motor parking signal.


Operation 2. (Rear wiper intermittent switch)

- E. Rear wiper intermittent switch is ON.
- F. After 0.1 sec. (T1), rear wiper relay is activated once.
- G. After 6 sec. (T2) of deactivation, rear wiper relay is activated once again.

When turning ignition off during the rear wiper operation, the rear wiper operates until the rear wiper motor parking signal is received.

(7) Rain sensor operation



Data recognition time

The LIN communication is established when the ignition is turned ON, regardless of the wiper and light switch operation. Then the function for the LIN data is carried out with the wiper AUTO switch or AUTO light switch in the AUTO position.

The data from the rain sensor is recognized as 2 consecutive data.

Operation when data is recognized

Data OFF: Lo/HI relay output OFF.

Low speed signal: LO relay output ON (ON for at least 1 revolution), HI relay output OFF.

High speed signal: HI relay output ON (ON for at least 1 revolution), LO relay output ON.

The washer input is overridden during continuous operation of wiper (washer coupled wiper operation during intermittent operation).

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
(8) Power-up reminder wiper

- A. Windshield wiper auto switch is ON.
- **B.** Ignition key is cycled (ON \rightarrow OFF \rightarrow ON).






Operation 1.

- If rain sensor linked data does not indicate continuous wiper operation
- A. Windshield washer switch is ON.
- B. Communication with rain sensor is ignored. (can misread washer fluid as rain drops)
- C. Windshield washer linked wiper operation (T1)
- D. Rain sensor linked wiper operation (T2) starts after windshield washer linked wiper operation. However, if rain sensor linked wiper operation indicates washer linked wiper operation, only the windshield washer relay is activated while the windshield wiper keeps cycling.

NOTE

Even when the washer linked wiper operation is activated, the BCM sends the operation data to rain sensor.





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(10) Wiper sensitivity control

- A. Windshield wiper auto switch is ON with IGN ON (or IGN ON with windshield wiper auto switch ON).
- B. Wiper LO relay is operated within 0.3 sec. (T1)

The windshield wiper motor transmits the power to the wiper linkage according to the switch input by the driver to operate the wiper arm and blade. The wiper motor operates at different speeds according to the activated terminal (HI or LO). The motor also incorporates a parking switch which receives the signal from the wiper switch and returns the wiper to the parking position during the wiper operation.



The wiper linkage connects the wiper motor and wiper arm. This linkage converts the rotational movement of the motor to back and forth movement to activate the wiper arms.



The wiper blade is made of rubber. Regular maintenance is required to keep the angle between the blade and glass surface at 90 degrees.


The washer system sprays the washer fluid onto the windshield and rear glass surfaces.

The windshield washer fluid reservoir tank supplies the washer fluid for both the windshield and rear washer systems.

The windshield washer nozzles are installed on both sides of the hood panel (one on each side). The nozzle sprays washer fluid in fan-shape to cover the windshield area as much as possible.




For a vehicle with spoiler, the rear washer nozzle is integrated with high mounted stop lamp. For a vehicle without spoiler, the nozzle is mounted on top of the tailgate.



The reservoir tank stores and supplies washer fluid, and has front and rear washer motor. The windshield washer fluid reservoir supplies the rear washer fluid without additional washer fluid reservoir.



7810-00 WIPER (HIGH, LOW) RELAY

1) Overview

There are two wiper relays: HIGH and LOW. These relays are a 5-pin and 3-way type. The relay is connected to the ground in normal conditions and connected to the motor only when it is activated (supplied with power).

8610-09 AUTO LIGHT AND RAIN SENSOR SYSTEM

1) Overview

The rain sensor is located in the center on the top of the windshield. It communicates with BCM and makes the wipers to operate automatically in the rain sensing mode (multifunction switch wiper: AUTO mode). The emitting section of the rain sensor unit emits infrared rays against the windshield and then detects the amount of rain drops by receiving reflected rays with photodiode. Then, the unit operates the wipers at high or low speed based on this data for the driver's convenience.





Rain sensor (integrated with AUTO light sensor)



The rain sensor communicates with the BCM and activates the wiper automatically in the rain sensing mode (multifunction switch wiper: AUTO mode). This sensor module emits infrared rays through the windshield glass and then detects the amount of rain drops by receiving the rays reflected off the sensing section (rain sensor mounting section on the windshield) with photodiode. The sensing section on the windshield is located just above the center point between the LED and photodiode.





Emitter lens

The LED which emits the infrared rays is located at the bottom and the lens guides the infrared rays to a target point.



6) Features

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(1) Windshield glass and coupler attachment

Check the sensing area on the outer windshield surface for excessive wear, damage or scratch. The sensor is able to compensate the wear up to a specific level. Check if there are too many air pockets left between the surfaces of the coupler and windshield. If the porosity exists, the sensor cannot function properly.

♦ NOTE

If the installed wiper blade is not as specified (size and length), the wiper cannot wipe the rain sensing area clearly.

In this case, the sensitivity of the rain sensor could be decreased and the wiper could be malfunctioning.

(2) Recognition of AUTO wiper mode

The wiper cycles once when the multifunction wiper switch is turned from OFF to AUTO.

This wiper operation is performed only for the first time. If the switch is turned from OFF to AUTO again, the wiper is operated only when raining to prevent the wiper blade from wearing.

The wiper is operated up to 3 minutes after the rain stops.

If this operation is not performed, check the terminal no. 2 of the rain sensor. If the terminal is intact, check the wiper relay (LOW).



🐇 NOTE

As described above, the BCM recognizes the wiper switch AUTO position If there is no problem, enter the diagnostic mode for BCM, check the terminal which receives the signals from the wiper, or check the communication line between the rain sensor unit and BCM.

(3) Instant wiping

Each time the speed control of the multifunction wiper switch is turned by one step from LOW to HIGH, the wiper cycles one time.

As with power-up function described above, the wiper continues works if it's rainy or for up to 3 minutes after the rain stops.



👃 NOTE

The wiper also cycles one time when the variable resistance knob is turned straight from the 0 to step 4, from 0 to step 1, from step 1 to step 2, and from step 2 to step 3.

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(4) Washer coupled wiper operation

Check the washer coupled wiper operation by pressing the washer switch.

(5) Irregular operation (abrupt operation)

- Check the rain sensor is correctly positioned.
- Check if the rain sensor cover is securely installed.
- Check if the customer is familiar with how to control the wiper sensitivity.
 That is, check if the customer knows how to select the desired sensitivity by selecting one of the 5 variable resistance values (step 1 to step 5). Check if the wiper sensitivity control is set to the FAST side (step 5).
- Check the wiper blades for wear.
 If the wiper blade cannot wipe the glass uniformly and clearly, it may cause the rain sensor to work irregularly. Therefore, in this case, replace the wiper blade with a new one.

(6) Self diagnosis

▶ Poor sensing

When the wiper speed control switch is turned to step 2 from step 3 the wiper motor cycles one time at low speed, provided that the BCM receives a faulty sensor signal from the rain sensor unit with IGN ON and the INT/AUTO switch ON.



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5) System Troubleshooting Procedures



▶ DTC check

Symptom 1. The wiper does not cycle one time when turning the multifunction wiper switch from OFF to AUTO position or when starting the engine with the multifunction wiper switch in AUTO position.

- 1. When starting the engine with the multifunction wiper switch in AUTO position, the wiper always cycles one time to remind the driver of system in AUTO mode.
- 2. Also, the wiper cycles once when the multifunction wiper switch is turned from OFF to AUTO. This wiper operation is performed only for the first time. If the switch is turned from OFF to AUTO again, the wiper is operated only when raining to prevent the wiper blade from wearing.

The wiper cycles once when the multifunction wiper switch is turned from OFF to AUTO position during 5 minutes after the rain stops. If the wiper does not work as specified, check the pin no. 8. If the pin is intact, check the terminals related to the wiper relay.

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Symptom 2. It rains but the wipers do not work with the wiper switch in AUTO position.

- 1. Check if the multi-function wiper switch is in AUTO position.
- 2. Check the power to the sensor. That is, check the pin no. 3 (ground) and pin no. 4 (IGN).
- 3. Check the wiper relay.

Symptom 3. The wiper cycles 3 or 4 times at high speed abruptly.

Check if the variable resistance knob of the multifunction wiper switch is set to the FAST side. The sensitivity is highest in FAST position. Therefore, the wiper can be easily operated for the small change of the rain drops. To avoid this, adjust the knob to lower the sensitivity level.

Symptom 4. The wiper continues work even if the windshield glass is dry.

- 1. Check the wiper blades for wear. If the wiper blade cannot wipe the glass uniformly and clearly, this problem could occur. In this case, replace the wiper blade with a new one.
- 2. Check whether the variable resistance knob on the multifunction wiper switch is set in "FAST". The sensitivity is highest in FAST position. Therefore, the wiper can be easily operated for very small of water. To avoid this, adjust the knob to lower the sensitivity level.

Symptom 5. The wiper does not work at high speed during heavy rain.

You should check the pin no. 1 and no. 2 unless the wiper cycles at higher speed during heavy rain. The wiper should cycle at high speed if the pins no. 1 and no. 2 are grounded.

Symptom 6. The overall wiper response is too fast or slow.

Check if the variable resistance knob of the wiper switch is set to the FAST or SLOW side. Inform the customer that the desired sensitivity can be set by using the variable resistance. And select a proper step for the customer.

HOW TO ADJUST WINDSHIELD WIPER ARM ANGLE

(1) Overview

The wiper blade should be replaced depending on its material and usage. However, poor tightening torque for the mounting bolt of the wiper arm or deformed wiper arm may cause the change interval to be shortened or the wiper not to wipe the windshield evenly.

It is important for these vehicles to measure the attack angles of the windshield glass and wiper blade (including movement angle of wiper arm) to adjust the wiper arm angle with a separate adjuster (see illustration below) by using the following procedures.

However, it would be extremely rare to correct the angle using the adjuster, since the most wiper arms are installed to the vehicle by considering the angle for the windshield glass. Please refer to the following information on mounting angle to check the wiper for abnormal wiping.



A CAUTION

- Note that the wiper may not operate properly with normal angle and wiper arm if the wiper blade
 has been worn or the windshield glass is coated, before measuring the wiper arm's attach angle.
 The following wiper attack angle and return angle are based on the angle for the windshield glass
